

COMPANY ARRANGEMENTS FOR FIRST AID

Our policy is to ensure that there is adequate and appropriate equipment, facilities and personnel to enable first aid to be given to employees or sub-contractors if they become ill or injured at work. The aim is to give immediate attention and to call an ambulance in serious cases.

Due to the nature of the work we undertake First Aid arrangements are nearly always a shared facilities agreement with main contractors and premises site managers.

Before work commences we will check that there is at least the minimum first aid provision of:

- A suitably stocked first-aid box.
- An appointed person to take charge of first-aid arrangements.

On the rare occasions that there is not a shared facilities agreement for first aid then our qualified and appointed first aid provider Matthew Smith will provide:

- A suitably stocked first-aid box and explanation of its use.
- Issue a copy of the HSE leaflet 'basic advice on first aid at work' and discuss the information it contains.

This arrangement will be reviewed annually.
